Neighbors helping neighbors reaching out in their congregations and in their community.



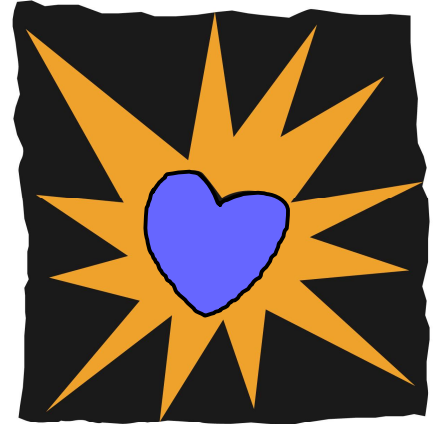
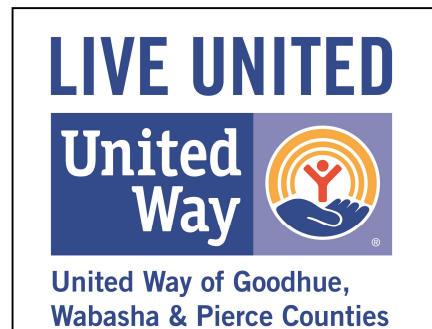
Generous, caring people who share their gifts in helping others.

in the following areas:

Friendly Visiting

Volunteers visit individuals in their homes. The purpose is to provide socialization and reduce isolation and loneliness. Visits are weekly or bi-weekly, as scheduled.



Transportation Local

Volunteer drivers transport individuals to local appointments. Volunteers use their own vehicle, and there is no remuneration for mileage.



Respite

Volunteers provide 2 - 3 hours of relief to allow full-time caregivers time to attend a support group meeting, shop, or enjoy a personal activity



Transportation Road-to-Recovery

Volunteers transport cancer patients to out-of-town health care centers for radiation treatment. Remuneration for mileage is provided.



Office Assistance

Volunteers assist staff in miscellaneous Activities, such as collating newsletters, or other tasks that might be needed

Book-House- Calls

In conjunction with the Red Wing Public Library *volunteers will pick-out, deliver or return books for those unable to do so for themselves..*
